## Sermon

### The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty,

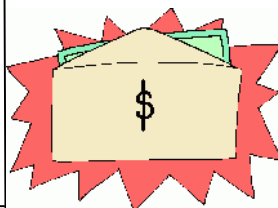

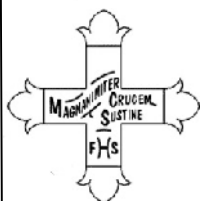

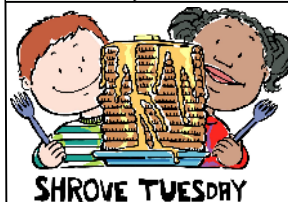
